

## **Ronald L. Williams, Attorney, Williams & Bradbury, P.C.,**

Ronald L. (“Ron”) Williams is an attorney in Boise Idaho and a shareholder in the firm of Williams Bradbury, P.C. Ron serves as general counsel to the Idaho Energy Resources Authority.

From 1982 - 1990 Mr. Williams served as counsel to Idaho Power Company, primarily in areas of state and federal regulation of electric utilities, and on matters of general corporate law and taxation. In 1990 Ron entered private practice where he has represented a variety of clients in energy and regulated utility matters. He currently serves as counsel to and part-time Executive Director of the Idaho Consumer-Owned Utilities Association (“ICUA”) where he represents the collective public policy and legal interests of Idaho electric cooperatives and municipalities at both the state and federal level. ICUA was the principal sponsor of and legislative proponent behind the creation of the Idaho Energy Resources Authority.

Mr. Williams is also Vice President and General Counsel of Mountain View Power, Inc. (MVP), a Boise based energy development company. MVP recently completed construction of the 168 MW Bennett Mountain natural gas fired power plant in Mountain Home, Idaho, under contract for Idaho Power Company.

Ron grew up in Boise, obtained his undergraduate degree in both business and economics from the University of Idaho in Moscow, Idaho and his law degree from Lewis and Clark College in Portland, Oregon. He lived in Portland for several years following law school, working as a tax consultant for Touche Ross & Co., before returning to Boise.

Ron is married to Sara Williams, a professional musician, recently retired as principal flutist of the Boise Philharmonic Orchestra. They have twin boys who are both college freshmen.
